Signature of Person Asking for Occupational Driver’s License

*Pursuant to Texas Civil Practices and Remedies Code Section 132.001, an unsworn declaration may be used in lieu of a written sworn declaration, verification, certification, oath or affidavit required by statute or required by rule, order or requirement adopted as provided by law. This provision does not apply to an oath of office or an oath required to be taken before a specified official other than a notary public. An unsworn declaration made under this section must be 1) in writing, 2) signed by the person making the declaration as true under penalty of perjury and 3) in substantially the form used above.

- An SR22 from your insurance company providing proof of current valid auto liability insurance.
- Proof of need to drive: Examples of proof: A letter from your employer or immediate supervisor on your employer’s letterhead that verifies your work schedule, school registration with schedule, or your sworn affidavit explaining to the court why you need to drive unless your license is suspended solely based on an intoxication offense under Penal Code 49.04-49.08 and any vehicle you own or operate must be equipped with an interlock device with camera that provides a clearly visible image of the individual using the interlock.
