

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT OF COURT APPOINTED ATTORNEY

1. Answer each question completely.
2. If the question does not apply to you, place a N/A in the blank.
3. If you are currently unemployed, you must explain who is supporting you and/or how your basic needs are met.
4. You must list all income sources available to you including your spouse/partner's financial information, as well as your parent's financial information if claimed as a dependent or supported by your parents.
5. For the court to make a finding of indigence, you **must** attach supporting documentation, such as: (1) proof of government assistance received in your name, (2) tax return, (3) last 3 pay stubs and any other documentation to support your request. A finding of indigence **will not** be determined without supporting documentation.
6. Court appointed attorneys are not necessarily free. If the court determines that you are able to offset in part or in whole the costs of the legal services provided , you will be ordered to pay during the pendency of the charges or, if convicted, as a reimbursement fee.
7. This Affidavit is a government document and all information provided must be true and correct. Providing false information is a CRIMINAL offense.
