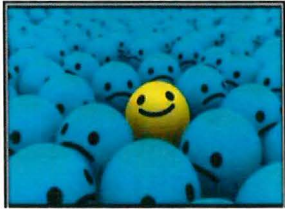


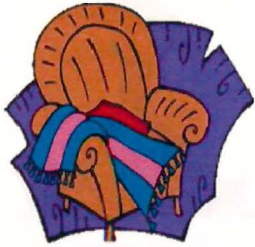
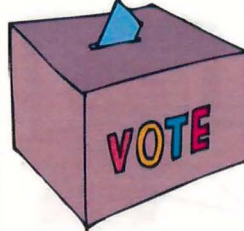
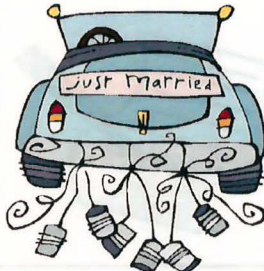
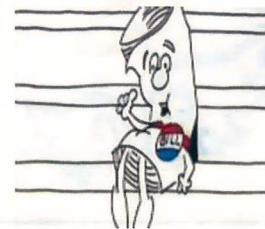
BILL OF RIGHTS

Have copies of the guardianship order and letter of guardianship. 	Have the contact information for the probate court. 	Development, self-reliance and independence. 	Be treated with respect, recognition, dignity and individuality. 	Live where you choose. 	Have supported services. 
Have preferences and opinions. 	Have an allowance. 	See a doctor. 	Have control of your life. 	Submit complaints without fear. 	Communicate in your native language. 
Have a complaint investigated. 	Participate in social settings. 	Participate in religious activities. 	Participate in recreational activities. 	Employment. 	Rehabilitation.
