RESOLUTION LEVYING A TAX RATE
FOR THE COUNTY OF BRAZOS
FOR THE TAX YEAR 2026

WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court is responsible for the levy for adoption of a tax rate for Brazos County

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Commissioners' Court of Brazos County, Texas does hereby levy or adopt the tax rate on \$100 of valuation for the County of Brazos for the tax year 2026 as follows

\$0 405000 for the purpose of maintenance and operations
\$0 038474 for the payment of principal and interest on county debt
\$0 443474 **Total Tax Rate**

THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S RATE.

THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 2.17 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$15.55.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the tax assessor/collector is hereby authorized to assess and collect the taxes of Brazos County in Accordance with the above set rate

Tax Increase

Ratification of the property tax increase due to the adoption of the budget that will require more revenue from property taxes than in the previous year.

This budget will raise more revenue from property taxes than last year's budget by an amount of \$11,336,310 which is a 9.04 percent increase from last year's budget. The property tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year is \$4,964,599.
